Western National Roundup is a youth leadership conference of national prominence and includes educational activities and national contests. Contests that are included in Western National Roundup are the National 4-H Horse Classic - Western Division, 4-H Consumer Decision Making Contest, National 4-H Family and Consumer Science (FCS) Presentations, National 4-H Home Economics Bowl, National 4-H Public Speaking - Prepared and Impromptu, National Western 4-H/FFA Meat Judging Contest and the National Western 4-H/FFA Livestock Judging Contest. Youth who attend gain new knowledge and experiences by participating in a variety of educational activities, tours, discussions and hands-on experiences.

Collegiate 4-H members are needed to help run each event run smoothly and serve as role models and facilitators to the youth. Applicants need not be members of a formally organized Collegiate 4-H program, but must be currently enrolled in an institute of higher education. Individuals selected for this program will receive room and board throughout the conference, but transportation costs are the responsibility of each individual. Individuals should be prepared to put in long hours and have lots of fun. This is a great opportunity to meet 4-H members from across the nation as well as other collegiate 4-H members. Collegiate applicants may not be delegates or contestants involved in the current year=s program.
